"Remember the days of old, consider the years of many generations: ask thy father, and he will shew thee; thy elders, and they will tell thee.".



#### INTRODUCTION

It is called **Deuteronomy "The Book of Journals"** for Moses reviews Israel's history in the wilderness, emphasizing that Jehovah had been always faithful to his covenant, even though Israel had been unfaithful.

The first generation who left Egypt had died. Also, only a few from the second generation had witnessed the marvelous works God had performed in the early years, while being children. Others had not even heard or seen them (because they had not been born yet), therefore they did not understand them. Therefore, Moses recounted all of God's works in this book.

# 1) REMEMBER

In chapters 1 through 3, Moses reviews the history of the pilgrimages of the people of Israel in the wilderness. It reminds them that the first generation had missed the opportunity to enter Canaan because of their disbelief and rebellion. It also reminds them that God had blessed them in everything (2:7)

## 2) OBEY

#### Deuteronomio 4:40

Considering what had happened to the previous generation, Moses earnestly appeals to Israel not to make the same mistake, to keep the law and put it into action. For if they obeyed the law, they would live and take possession of Canaan (chapter 4).

The Ten Commandments were the foundation of the covenant the Lord made with Israel.

They are called "testimonies" (4:45), for they are the revelation of divine character, will, and purpose. Home should be a school where God is taught to worship, it is a mandate from God to all parents (6:6-9)



### 3) PAY ATTENTION

Moses lists the blessings and curses extensively and in various details (chapter 28). The entrance of the Israelites into the promised land was up to them, their destiny was before them.


Obedience would bring blessing and disobedience would bring curse. If the Israelites had heeded Moses' warnings, they would have been saved from great suffering throughout their history.
